



Potato Baker Bags...

Supplies:

- (1) 9 x 21" cotton fabric for outside of bag
- (1) 9 x 21" cotton fabric for inside of bag
- (1) 9 x 21" cotton batting

1. Layer fabric in this order: batting, outside fabric right side up, inside fabric wrong side up.
2. Stitch a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam across each short end.
3. Turn so the batting is between both fabrics. Each fabric's right side should be facing out. Press.
4. Quilt bag.
5. Sew side seams. From the lining side, fold a 2" lip down on a short side. Then fold the other short end up so it is about 1" from the top. The 2 short ends should be overlapping about 1".
6. Stitch both long sides in a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. Finish the edges by serging or zig-zag.
7. Turn the bag right side out. Flip the fold over to close the bag.

Include this information with your Baked Potato Bag:

Baked Potato Bag

The best baked potato that you have ever eaten!

Wash and dry your potatoes.

Do NOT prick potatoes.

Wrap potatoes in a paper towel and place in the bag.

Microwave 4-8 minutes, time will vary.

When serving, do not cut with a knife, simply use a fork!

The potatoes will be very fluffy!

Let the bag air dry.

Enjoy your yummy baked potatoes!!
